REQUIREMENTS

Student Ambassadors must:

- Be undergraduate students of Level 4 and above / Postgraduate students (level 7).
- Have good written and oral English communication skills.
- Demonstrate a positive attitude and strong work ethics.
- Represent WIUT at local area schools, learning centres and other organisations.
- Serve as Orientation Leaders and greet international students during the first week of the semester.
- Develop relationships within the community that encourage students to attend WIUT.

The role of the Student Ambassador is vital to WIUT. It is important for students to treat this as a "real" job and perform their job duties, projects and assignments in a serious, responsible and professional manner as they represent our University.
