



UK TNE Provision

Uzbekistan is the leading country in the region for UK TNE, accounting for 85% of all enrolments amongst the seven countries included in this study





BC Wider Europe

- Uzbekistan accounts for 62% of all UK TNE in the Wider Europe region
- If it was a single 'country', Wider Europe (16,025) would be the 10th largest market for UK TNE
- The majority of the region remains under-developed for UK TNE

UK TNE Snapshot

UK TNE Enrolments in Uzbekistan over 5-years





- Registered at reporting provider - studying overseas for UK HEP award other than at an overseas campus of reporting provider
- Registered at reporting provider - distance, flexible and distributed learning for UK HEP award where the location of the student is known to be overseas
- Registered at overseas partner organisation studying overseas for an award of the reporting provider

Uzbekistan has become a significant regional education hub, with 219 higher education institutions, with growth driven by private and international stakeholders

Policy Environment

- Concept of Development of Higher Education
- Ambition to have 10 universities in the global top 1000
- Attract more IBCs of high quality
- New Uzbekistan
 Development Strategy
- Raise GER to 50%
- Develop financial autonomy and academic freedom
- Boost research and innovation

Regulatory Environment

- Regulatory environment is overseen by Ministry
- Each institution must undergo attestation every five years
- Monitoring of quality of education related to labour market needs
- Ministry co-ordinates the training of HE staff

TNE Snapshot

- Very strong TNE growth since 2018, with 23 IBCs established
- 3rd largest IBC hub in the world
- University of Westminster is oldest IBC, since 2002
- Majority of newer IBCs are Russian
- Malaysia, Italy, Singapore, India and South Korea also represented
- Large variety of courses ranging from Finance to Public Health and Fashion
