Dear friends of WIUT!

We are glad to note that the diverse range of clubs and societies of the University organised by the Students' Union, the traditional events, such as the Talent Show, the Fashion Show, the Culture Fair and many others increasingly engage not only the students and staff at our University, but also the students of our partner institutions and universities. This enables the exchange of ideas and development of the youth's creative potential.

This year's Almanac reviews the activities of two consecutive academic years as the biggest part of which the world was engulfed in the COVID-19 pandemic. In the conditions of the alobal lockdown and the remote study mode, social engagement of students was challenging. However, at the same time this served as an impetus for the University to explore alternative online methods of administering socio-cultural projects. In the summer of 2020, students were invited to participate in the Lockdown Unlocks Creativity contest, which was extremely well received by students undergoing the pressure of psychological side-effects of social isolation. The competition gave them an opportunity to feel the community spirit, while at the same time encouraging them to explore their creative skills and talents.

Another bright example of the most successful projects of the term in review was the Photo-Art Exhibition held on the occasion of the 28th Anniversary of Uzbekistan's Independence, which became part of the International Biennale of Contemporary Art in Tashkent. There has been welcoming praise and positive reviews offered by the representatives of the Arts Academy and the renowned national artists of Uzbekistan in regards to the works of WIUT students providing a solid foundation for further development of our collaboration.

I sincerely hope that as you look through the pages of this Almanac you come to share our views on the importance of students' socio-cultural engagement and wellbeing.

Preface

The State Youth Policy Law was approved in September 2016 bringing a new impetus to the support of youth in Uzbekistan and spurring the efforts of both public and private sector institutions in enhancing the personal, intellectual, physical, moral and spiritual development of the nation's youth. Special focus has been placed on the work to develop the quality of education and in raising graduate employability through the growth of the creative, intellectual and entrepreneurial potential of young people, stimulation of innovative activity amongst students, young scientists and entrepreneurs.

This was further supported through the National Action Strategy on Five Priority Development Areas for 2017-2021 which was put forward by the President of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev. Specifically, this Strategy placed emphasis on raising social engagement of youth with the purpose of supporting their physical, spiritual and intellectual development, enhancement of their entrepreneurial and creative potential through broad engagement in social, cultural and sports activities. This year, yet again, the President highlighted the importance of the Youth programme by announcing 2021 as the "Year of Supporting Youth and Strengthening the Population's Health".

This Almanac is portrayed as an images gallery that brings together some of the most notable highlights from the social and cultural life of WIUT, student initiatives and projects, which support their all-round development. The images present a range of the events held by the University administration, clubs, societies and student organizations in the academic years 2019-2020 and 2020-2021.



















ZAKOVAT






ONLINE Events






